
Caramel Apple Recipe:

PROPERTY SERVICE UPDATE

TENANT TIP TIME:

It may be 90 degrees outside today but at the end of September we gear up for FALL!!!!

That means:

- Heating Season
- Please change your furnace filters monthly
- Please vacuum out and/or remove items from in front of your return air intakes (larger grills in your wall) this will help the furnace operate more efficiently and keep the air circulating
- Please set your thermostats to 72 degrees when home and 68 degrees when out



- Please make sure all windows are closed
- BOILERS will be started up at the end of September/ First Week of October
- Those tenants with Boilers—the goal is to have the building as a whole at a constant temperature.

- Our units do not have individual control of temperatures.
- ⇒ So some units will be warmer and/or colder as the building tries to regulate itself
- ⇒ Please make sure all exterior doors are closed
